RAPID INTERVENTION TEAM – REFRESHER TRAINING

Students who have attended a Rapid Intervention Team (RIT) Operations team course should refresh their skills. Our “refresher” program takes the skills and techniques that are presented in the initial operations class and brings back an aggressive training version.

SWIFT WATER RESCUE – AWARENESS (NFPA 1670)

Water Rescue Awareness for First Responders is designed to introduce emergency services personnel who respond to water emergency incidents. All responders must recognize the risks and dangers of rescues in moving swift water and know what actions to take to ensure personal, team and scene safety.

This Awareness Level program is a classroom session. It will present students with the need for water rescue, scene safety, management, training, resources, equipment and identification of “rescue” versus “recovery” operations. This program meets NFPA 1670 – Standards on Operations and Training for Technical Rescue Incidents – Water Search and Rescue.

Water Rescue and Emergency Response – Operations Level covers shore-based rescue operations.

This program introduces students to in-water activities, including demonstrating swimming proficiency in a controlled water environment (swimming pool). In addition, the program covers planning for water emergencies, moving water dynamics, medical conditions, personal safety and fundamental rescue techniques. This class requires students to engage in strenuous in-water activities. It also requires all students to have their own (or department issued) personal protective equipment. This Operations Level program is mostly hands-on. Students are to be physically fit and capable of fulfilling all skills in order to successfully complete this program. This program meets NFPA 1670 – Standards on Operations and Training for Technical Rescue Incidents – Water Search and Rescue.
